President Biden Builds Back Better

Health

- Uninsured Americans under 65 has dropped from 14.5% to 11.8% and while that is still too high it is a considerable improvement. The unemployment rate for people of color is at a near record low.
- Veterans with health issues from being exposed to toxic burn pits, now have VA coverage for those issues.

Economy

- President Biden's policy has seen 12 Million people find jobs resulting in the unemployment rate dropping to a 50 year low of 3.4%.
- Biden's policies on inflation are beginning to work as prices have begun to stabilize.
- Medicare now has the legal authority to negotiate drug prices with drug companies, insurance companies have done this for years but Medicare was prohibited from doing so. This will bring savings in the coming years as the program is implemented.
- For years are Presidents have recognized the need for a program to deal with our aging infrastructure, but none have been able to get a bill passed. President Biden was able to work with both sides of the aisle to get a bill passed. Not only will this begin to restore, replace and upgrades so much that is needed, but it will create good paying American jobs to do this work.
- Projects that will bring more sustainable power will reduce our vulnerability to the price gouging by foreign energy companies in addition to reducing the polution in our air.

Foreign Policy
